

Union Aid Abroad-APHEDA is the overseas humanitarian aid agency of the Australian council of Trade Unions and expresses the union movement's commitment to social justice through support to overseas education, training and development projects, working in partnership with those whose rights to development are restricted or denied.

Each year, Union Aid Abroad has a fundraising dinner that attracts 380 people.

Currently, Union Aid Abroad is searching for 1 - 2 African musicians/performers to perform at the 2006 Make Life Fair Everywhere annual fundraising dinner. The dinner will be held at Petersham RSL, on September 20 this year.

Ideally we were looking for world music with a specifically African influence or fusion between various musical styles.

Specifically services will be required for approximately 4 hours on the evening, however, this is not a continuous run and musicians will be paid \$200 for their services and will also be fed.

It is also necessary for the musicians to supply their own PA equipment.
